What is "The Greeters"?

The concept was invented in New York to allow visitors to discover the city through its inhabitants. Now numerous cities (Houston, Paris, Buenos Aires) have their own greeters. Each different, but all complying with the international Greeters Charter on a volunteer and free-of-charge basis, a charter complied with by the Marseille Provence Greeters.

Local inhabitants as Greeters, offer custom visits to show the typical sights but also unusual addresses, hidden treasures, special encounters, local traditions and the great history of Marseille and Provence.

Apart from being a genuine tourism alternative, this action is on a free-of-charge, volunteer and cultural exchange basis.

MAABN and MP Greeters plan to organize once a year, a shared event to develop stronger links between our members.

They will promote each others and visiting tourists will be invited to attend MAABN's "Language Apéros" and other events if appropriate.

After the success of Marseille, MP Greeters will be in AVIGNON on JULY 3rd , 5.30 pm.

It creates links between the region, its inhabitants and visitors, giving inhabitants a richer experience of their own town and visitors a better grasp of them and immersion in them.
