Thomas Enqvist Biography

Thomas Enqvist is of Swedish origin and has been playing tennis since the young age of 4 years old. In 1991, he won both the Australian Open and Wimbledon making him the number 1 rank junior player in the world. Thomas Enqvist's highest ranking was number 4 in the world and finished the year in the Top 10 players four times during his career.
